ELCA Youth Gathering - 2024



This summer, our small but mighty group of four will be heading down to New Orleans, Louisiana (often referred to NOLA) for the 2024 ELCA Youth Gathering. Participants Caleb and Liam Crumpton, accompanied by Jennifer Crumpton and Pastor Jeff, will experience five days of faith formation through worship, interactive learning, Bible study, service, and fellowship.

The event kicks off on July 16th with the first "Mass Gathering" at The Smoothie King Center (the basketball stadium) where 30,000 youth and adults from across the country will unite under the theme "Created to Be." At mass gatherings, they will experience worship on a grand scale with guest speakers, music, and lots of enthusiasm.

The HOILP Creation Care Corp (CCC) met on April 17th at Immanuel. Three major pieces of business were accomplished. First, the following mission was adopted for the CCC:

To incorporate care for creation into the identify and mission of HOILP so that there is a spirt of care for God's Earth in all that we do.

And second, they will be asking each council to review HOILP Care-for-Creation Covenant and discuss and adopt it at their May meetings. This covenant is modeled after the one provided by Lutherans Restoring Creation, a national grassroots organization that exists for the same reason as HOILP's CCC, only to keep the ELCA focused on Creation.

And finally, it was decided the CCC would meet bi-monthly on the second Wednesday of the month. So the next meeting will be June 12, 2024. All are welcome.

Challenge - Bag Free Month of May

No plastic bags. Like really, NO BAGS. Why?

- Plastic grocery bags dissolve into harmful microplastics and, hurting and killing animals.
- Even though they are technically recyclable, they must go to a special location and cannot be put in your curbside bin or local drop off.
- They are the #1 contaminant in recycling loads.
- They act as "tanglers," getting caught in machinery and shutting down equipment.

<u>Rule of thumb</u>: If you can carry your purchases to the checkout, you don't need a bag to carry them to your car. Too much to carry? Take re-useable bags with you when you shop.
