He's Back and So Are We!!!!!!

For the first time since 2019, the congregations of Heart of Illinois Lutheran Parish will be holding Easter Sunday worship services in their sanctuaries. "As we celebrate the resurrection we are also resurrecting our worship services," said Pastor Jeff.

Easter services will follow the regular Sunday morning schedule: 8:30 a.m. at Immanuel and 10:30 a.m. at First.

Typically Immanuel holds a sunrise service with their Easter breakfast to follow while First hosts their Easter breakfast prior to worship. But since the councils chose to hold off a bit longer before hosting full community meals, Immanuel chose to maintain their normal worship time for this year.

In 2020 when the shutdown happened in the midst of Lent, we all thought we'd be back together by

Easter. When that did not occur, Pastor Jeff promised to hold Easter services when we were back. He feels bad that he never fulfilled that promise. "In my defense," he said, "we never really came back fully – not without restrictions anyway.

Still today we're transitioning back to prepandemic practices."

He teased the councils that he has three years of Easter sermons bottled up inside him. They responded by saying that they would instruct Sarah and Ron to begin playing at the 15 minute mark.

There will be a video service for Easter as well. But all who are healthy are encouraged to join us in person to celebrate the resurrection.

Grungy Sunday Coming to First

First Lutheran will be having "Grungy Sunday" on May 15, 2022.

What is Grungy Sunday? It's the day you come to worship dressed in your grungy clothes.

Why have a grungy Sunday? Because we're going to stay after worship to do spring cleaning for the church and for the parsonage.



Please plan on staying following worship on that day as we haven't had a spring cleaning and there are a number of tasks that need to be done. Lunch will be provided, so you need not worry about going away hungry.

If you know of any jobs that need to be completed, please contact Alex or Jim Johnson who are compiling the list and prioritizing the jobs.

Benevolence Box at First

You may have note the wooden box that says "Amazing Grace" in the narthex at First Lutheran. That is the benevolence box.

The First Lutheran council recommended and it was approved at the annual meeting that in 2022 traditional benevolence gifts would be funded through retiring offerings rather than via the budget. This does relieve some pressure on the budget, but also allows a chance to make our gifts we make for the good of the world more personal. So on a bimonthly basis, a new recipient of our gifts will be named and worshipers will be invited to contribute.

In March and April, the offering is designated to aid Ukrainian refugees through Lutheran Disaster Response (LDR). LDR is the arm of the ELCA through which we respond to all sorts of crises throughout the world. They are partnering with Lutheran World Relief and Church World Service to most effectively get the aid where it is needed.

Transitioning with the Pandemic

The following guidelines were endorsed by at the March 12 joint HOILP council meeting regarding continued transitions as the pandemic dissipates. They are simply guidelines and will be altered as needed.

Mask Requirements

- Masks are no longer required at worship.
- Be prepared to reinstate mask requirement should spikes and/or state or local mandates take place

Worship

- Communion
 - Begin coming forward communion rather than remain at seats.
 - No assistants initially. Pastor (masked) will administer both bread and wine
 - If infection rates continue to decrease, then begin including communion assistants Easter Sunday and going forward
- Offering
 - Continue to collect at the door and bring it forward at the time of offering
 - Going forward – consider whether we want to reintroduce passing of the plates or make the baskets at the door our norm
- Sharing of the Peace
 - Continue sharing the peace in place as we have been
 - If infection rates continue to decrease, begin a more traditional sharing of the peace after Easter Sunday
- Online Worship
 - Strive to maintain an online presence. For now – continue as we have been the last 9 months – a more brief service published weekly
 - Going forward – explore options to record Sunday morning services and either broadcast live or release the video following the service sometime
 - This option would...
 - ...relieve time pressure of recording sessions prior to service.
 - ...require investing in video recording equipment for one or both of the sanctuaries.
 - ...require people other than pastor doing video tasks.

Other Activities and Building Usage

- Allow various organizations such as WELCA, Youth, etc. to freely meet and set their own expectations regarding masks, etc. (in many ways this is already happening)
- Education
 - Confirmation – already meeting, will follow procedure of bullet above
 - BLAST – set a goal of relaunching in the Fall
- Building Usage for Meals
 - Prior to Easter - Allow private parties to use basements for meals with a reasonable size limit determined individually by each congregation
 - On and/or after Easter Sunday – begin to enjoy coffee and fellowship before/after worship (in overflow at Immanuel, upstairs at First, perhaps outside weather permitting)
 - After Easter – if infection rates continue to decline, begin to offer funeral meals sponsored by the congregation again.
 - After Memorial Day – again, assuming there is continual improvement, allow public meals such as potlucks, Ice Cream Social, fundraiser meals, etc.
