Lent Begins at the End of the Month

Lent kicks off on Ash Wednesday which falls on February 26th this year. Ash Wednesday service, which will include both imposition of ashes and holy communion, will be at 7:00 p.m. at First Lutheran. Following that our Wednesday evening Lenten suppers and worship will alternate between Immanuel and First.

We will again have the joy of participating in a Lenten Round Robin for our Wednesday services. Congregations participating include St. John's in Ashton, Emmanuel in Payne's Point (rural Oregon), Immanuel in Amboy, and Freedom in Oregon.

The theme for the Lenten services will be "at the name of Jesus." It is based around what is known as the Christ hymn in Philippians 2:5-11.

The full Lent and Easter schedule appears at the right. Lenten devotion booklets will be available later this month.

New Launch Date for **BLAST**

Due to inclement weather, we had to reschedule our planned launch of Sunday Night BLAST. So make sure you clear your evening on Sunday, February 16 as we blast off with BLAST.

Sunday Night BLAST is a new joint effort between First and Immanuel that will include worship, faith formation and fellowship. It is the result of the

"rethinking Sunday School" task force. But it is not a different time nor a different way of doing Sunday School.

"I look forward to joining with my children, and with people of all ages as we worship

together, learn about our faith together, and just have a whole lot of fun." said one member of the task force.



Being on Sunday evenings, it will offer an additional worship opportunity that might work better for the busy and varied schedules of today's families. And since it will be an entirely different worship than on Sunday morning plus a learning activity, it will offer an opportunity for people of all ages to come and dig deeper into their faith.

"I am really excited! This is the first significant ministry we have launched together as member congregations," Pastor Jeff commented. "We've shared many things like worship and supporting Another Child Foundation. But this is the first thing we've created together. Not only will it help us grow closer together, but it should be a great thing to invite our neighbors to."

Jeff's Jottings – Field Trip Anyone?

Last fall I led a small group of you on a “leaf peeping” trip to look for fall colors. We rented a van so we could all ride together. We enjoyed each other’s company as we traveled, got to see some beautiful backroads and parks of Illinois (and a little of Iowa), and had a great meal together at a little café. Those who went on the trip had a great time and wanted to know when we were going to do this type of thing again.

Last week, as I was leading a group of pastors in the “Season of Creation” retreat, I hatched the idea of leading a field trip for each of the Sundays of the season. This year’s Sundays for Season of Creation are Forest Sunday, Land & Prairie Sunday, Wilderness Sunday, and River & Stream Sunday. So, I’ve been thinking of places that would be interesting to visit that relate to each of those Sundays.

Now it would be a challenge to do all four field trips during the four weeks we celebrate the Season of Creation in September. Thus, I’d like to spread these day trips throughout the year. So here is what I have come up with:

- March 23rd – *Emiquon National Wildlife Refuge* (Wilderness) – A wilderness, by definition, would be a place that is not inhabited by people. Such places are not numerous in Illinois. But Emiquon and the surrounding area is one that our nation, our state, and numerous conservation organizations are trying to restore to its “wild” state. I’m timing the trip so that we can view the thousands and thousands of waterfowl that migrate through the area each spring. Last year I witnessed the incredible spectacle of snow geese that make this a temporary home. This trip will also include a stop at the Dickson Mounds Museum.

- May 4th – *National Mississippi River Museum and Aquarium* (River & Stream) – We will time our departure so that we can enjoy the beautiful ride on US 52 along the Mississippi River and arrive in Dubuque for an early lunch. We will then explore the museum and maybe another river attraction for the afternoon. After a stop for supper in Galena, IL, we’ll return home with more knowledge, bigger bellies, and a deeper love for the wonders of God’s grand creation.



- Summer (Land & Prairie) – This one is not fully planned out yet but I have some ideas. It may paired with a trip to the dinner theater at White Pines State Park. Keep an eye out in future newsletters for more details.
- October 26th (tentative date) – *Leaf Peeping Number Two* (Forest) – Last year’s trip was so enjoyable we’re going to do it again this year. But this time it will be a little bit later hoping to see more color. And it will also be in a different direction as we explore other parks and backroads of Northern Illinois. I’ll also make sure there is a stop at a good restaurant or café included in the day.

So there you have it. The first annual “Season of Creation” field trips. Each trip will include devotions, as well as various pieces of trivia and bad jokes along the way by yours truly. The cost for each trip will be the share of the rental van and any associated tickets.

Please come along with me for new adventures in 2020 as we explore God’s marvelous creation.

BLAST is coming to a church near you!

This article is reprinted from last month to share details about BLAST once again. Please join us on Sunday evening January 19th for the first BLAST event.

Sunday Night BLAST is coming to HOILP this January! “What is Sunday Night BLAST?” you ask. Well, it is a monthly multigenerational gathering at the congregations of HOILP which will include worship, faith formation activities and fellowship. The word BLAST is an acronym of **B**elieving, **L**earning and **S**erving **T**ogether.

The concept of Sunday Night BLAST came from the “rethinking Sunday School” task force. But it is important to point out that this will not be Sunday School simply moved to Sunday evenings. This is a wholly different and new type of event.

The key to it is that it is for all ages. Together young and old will learn and grow in faith. Together people of all ages will reach out and serve the world. Together, we’ll begin each BLAST event with a new and unique worship experience.

If people ask if there is Sunday School at Immanuel or First, our answer will be, “No, we don’t have Sunday School. But we have Sunday Night BLAST each month which is for everyone. Come and join us.”

Each BLAST event will begin with worship complete with communion. The worship service will be about 30 minutes in length and will be designed to engage people of all ages throughout the service.

Following worship, the group will head downstairs for a learning activity and/or a service opportunity. Though families are encouraged to attend BLAST together, they may be asked to divide up for the activities as we strive to expand and grow our relationships among one another.

BLAST will take place on the third Sunday of the month beginning January 19, 2020. It’ll start at 4:00 p.m. and go for about an hour and half. January’s Sunday Night BLAST will be at Immanuel while February will be at First with the intention of alternating from that point. The schedule through May can be seen on the right.

Each BLAST event will have its own leadership team of four people, usually led by Pastor Jeff. If you are able to sign up to help just one or two of the months during the year, that’d be a great help. To volunteer for any of the leadership teams or if you have any questions regarding BLAST, please talk to any of the task force members: Emily Betz, Jennifer Crumpton, Connie Schlesinger or Pastor Jeff.
