Lent 2024 - Seeds and Soil

The theme for Lent this year will be "Seeds and Soil." Revolving around Jesus' Parable of the Sower, Pastor Jeff will lead us as we look at the gospel of Mark with this parable as our guide.

Each Sunday during Lent, a theme will be introduced using one episode from the gospel of Mark. Then at the Wednesday evening Lenten services, the message will be a Bible study format and Pastor Jeff will expound upon how that theme plays out in the gospel, all the time looking at it through the "lens" of the Parable of the Sower.

The themes for the weeks will be Exorcising our Troubles, Healing our Divisions, Calming the Storms, Feeding our Neighbors, and Perceiving the Good News. We will experience turbulent waters, mercy seeking beggars, walking paralytics, and men who live in the graveyard.

First Council Highlights January 28, 2023

- A 2024 recommended budget was approved based on a proposed budget by Treasurer Deb Poterek with only a couple approved modifications.
- An agenda for the 2023 Annual Meeting was reviewed, modified, and approved for use at the annual meeting.
- Recipients for the Jan.-Feb. (Tails Humane Society), Mar.-Apr. (LSSI), and May-June (LOMC and Lutherdale) Benevolence Offering Box was approved by the Council.

Immanuel Council Highlights December 21, 2023

- Nov 30 General Treasury balance = \$4,353.88.
- Expenditures in November exceeded income by \$3,389.57.
- Weather permitting, the roof should be completed within the next week.
- The church has been sued for \$2,500 for an issue regarding the farm and a neighboring farm.
- Kim Menzel completes her council term in January, so a new council member is being recruited.

January 18, 2024

- Ending balance of the General Treasury on Dec. 31, 2023 = \$2,962.63.
- The net loss for the month = (\$1,391.25).
- General Treasury returned \$7,000.00 of the \$14,000.00 borrowed from the Capital Improvement Fund.
- Average 2023 Sunday attendance at Immanuel = 45.3 per Sunday, up slightly from 2022.
- February 14 is the small claims court trial date for
- farm property issue.
- The net farm income for 2023 was \$49,270.73.
 Recommended disbursement will be presented at the Annual Meeting.

Immanuel Annual Meeting Highlights January 28, 2023

- Pastor Jeff showed a video he made of the travel highlights during his sabbatical.
- In 2023, the General Treasury had a net loss of \$28,415.40. To offset the shortfall in offering and be able to pay general operating expenses, \$15,000.00 was transferred to the General Treasury from the Amdex account and \$14,000.00 was borrowed from the Capital Improvement fund.
- The \$100,000.00 received in 2010 from the Blum family that was turned into an Endowment Fund is now depleted. Over the last 14 years, half of the money was given away outside of the church.
- The net income from the farm in 2023 was \$49,270.73. The congregation approved distributing it as follows: \$9,854.15 (20%) to the Capital Improvement fund, \$18,000.00 towards our 2023 N. IL Synod commitment, \$9,000.00 to the Amdex account, \$7,000.00 to the Capital Improvement fund (to repay the balance borrowed for the General Treasury), \$1,000.00 to be divided between MASS, PADS & the Mendota Area Christian Food Pantry, the remaining \$4,416.58 to the Scholarship Fund (since the Blum Endowment Fund is now depleted).
- With the roof project completed, the Building & Grounds team is researching replacing the blacktop. The weight of the equipment from the roof project added to existing issues & repair is needed, so it's not a liability issue.
- Carol Kern volunteered to join council. Kim Menzel completed her council term.
